About This Packet:

This packet is intended for restoring firearm rights that were revoked as part of a criminal conviction. If your firearm rights were revoked due to mental health treatment, do not use this packet; review [Section 9.41.047 of the Revised Code of Washington](#) (RCW) for more information on that process.

This packet should **only** be used in King County Superior Court if a court in King County took away your firearms rights. If a court in a different Washington county took away your firearms rights, you have to ask the superior court in that county to give them back. If a court in a different state took away your firearms rights, you should consult with an attorney.

Asking the court to restore your right to possess a firearm is complicated. **It is not always possible to restore your rights.** To confirm that you qualify for restoration, review [Section 9.41.041 of the RCW](#) or contact an attorney. If you are prohibited from possessing a firearm due to multiple convictions, then you must restore your right to possess a firearm for **every** conviction. If after reviewing the RCW and/or consulting an attorney you believe you are eligible to reinstate your right to possess a firearm, then you can use this packet to complete the process.
